Top Hand

In the tradition of the Cowboy and the ranches of the west there is no higher compliment than being christened the top hand. All Cowboys worth their salt strive to be worthy of such a title. It is not a title given lightly nor one that is awarded to a man that hasn't put in their time. It is a title of honor and respect. While the Cowboy needed to be a man of many skills, including some of the dirtier ground crew work, the highest skill of the Cowboy and the one most respected was the horseman. In all the skills the Top Hand had mastered, it was his skill as horseman that most earned him the title.

General Information for Top Hand Competition

- 1. Open to Amateur and Open Riders, Clinicians and Professionals.
- 2. All riders and wranglers must be 18 years or older.
- 3. Riders may enter more than one horse. If a rider has more than one horse in top five, then the highest scoring horse **only** must be ridden.
- 4. All Cowboy Dressage World Rules will apply. www.cowboydressage.com/competition.html. If there is a conflict in Rule Verbiage These Top Hand Rules take precedence.
- 5. Part one of the Top Five Competition will be ridden by each competitor on their qualifying horse(s). All riders are aware that the top 5 competitors will be required to switch horses for the second ride of Top Five Competition on Saturday pm. The switch will be determined by a draw.
- 6. A separate Release of Liability must be signed for Top Hand Competition
- 7. Test used for Thursday qualifying round Cowboy Dressage Challenge Test Walk/Jog/Lope Test 2.
- 8. If there is a conflict of drawn ride times for riders with multiple horses then ride times will be managed by show office.
- 9. All riders must be members of The Cowboy Dressage World Hand Shake. This is mandatory. It is free. http://www.cowboydressage.com/images/pages/world/signup.html
- 10. If you are showing in the Cowboy Dressage Gathering and Finals, as well as Top Hand, a separate entry form will be required. However, only a one time fee is required for stall/tack and drug fees.
- 11. Wranglers are required for Top Five Horses. Wrangler stays with horse during switch.
- 12. For switch rides, rider may change the saddle but not the bridle.
- 13. Wrangler may offer water to horses, if needed.
- 14. All Top Hand Competition Tests will have only maneuvers or combination of maneuvers already required in our approved tests.
- 15. It is the Rider's responsibility to supply his/her own caller and wrangler.
- 16. Any top ten or top five qualifying horse may be substituted for another qualified horse if lame or sick with a vet certificate. Substituted horse will be moved into proper scoring position to determine if it will be among the top ten horses. Substitutions must take place no later than 30 minutes prior to start of class.
- 17. Top scores will be the accumulative scores from all 3 judges in both the preliminary and Top 5 tests.
- 18. Preliminary scores are not carried over to or added to Top Five scores

Substitution Rules

- 1. All horse substitutions require a vet certification
- 2. All rider substitutions require a medical certification
- 3. All vet or medical excuses for substitutions or horse or rider must be filed with show secretary 30 minutes before start of class Thurs Nov. 5, 2015
- 4. For top 5 only a rider who has two horses qualify for the top 5 can substitute their second scoring horse for the top 5 competition. If you do not have two horses in the top five, and one becomes enabled, then you are eliminated.
- 5. If a Top 5 horse is withdrawn for any reason and the rider does not have a 2nd placing horse in the Top 5 then the 6th place of the Top Ten will move up to the Top Five number 5 slot. This is progressive 6-10th placing's depending on substitutions needed.
- 6. Any Top 5 substitutions must be made by 4:30 Sat, Nov 7th in office.
- 7. Riders changes will not be accepted after the close of entries 10/15/15 up through 30 minutes prior to the start of class on November 5th.
- Example #1: A Top 5 rider who had two top 5 horses must show his highest scoring horse in the Top 5. If his first Top 5 horse has a vet excuse the rider can then opt to use his second scoring Top 5 horse. He may not substitute another horse not in the Top 5.
- Example #2: If a Top 5 rider's horse is not able to compete in the Top 5 due to injury or illness and the rider did not have a 2nd horse in the Top 5, the rider may not substitute another horse.
- Example #3: If a Top 5 horse is withdrawn for any reason and the rider does not have a 2nd placing horse in the Top 5 then the 6th place of the Top Ten will move up to the Top Five number 5 slot. This is a progressive 6-10 placing depending on substitutions needed.

Schedule for Top Hand Competition

Wednesday, November 4th

- 1. Draw by office at 3 pm for order of go for Thursday qualifying round. Riders may be present.
- 2. Order of go for qualifying round posted by Wed. Nov 4th, 7 PM at show office.

Thursday, November 5th

- 1. Qualifying Rides Take Place
- 2. Three Judges will Judge Qualifying Rides placed in 3 separate locations around the court.

Friday, November 6th

1. Top ten will be posted by numerical or alphabetic order by 5 pm at show office.

Saturday, November 7th

- 1. Top Ten Riders will be given the test pattern for the final competition at 4:30 PM, Show Office. There will be a member of the ground jury present to answer any questions regarding the execution of the pattern at that time.
- 2. Top Ten Riders/Horses will be presented in Arena 1 at 6:30 pm.
- 3. Must be mounted and ready to compete.
- 4. Top Ten will be announced.
- 5. Top Five will be announced.
- 6. Sixth Tenth Riders will stay in the arena as "buddy horses" with their riders, either mounted or on foot.
- 7. Draw to take place for order of first go round Top Five.
- 8. 6th place rider/horse should be on deck in warm up arena in case of any last second scratches.
- 9. Top Five Riders to be auctioned off in a Calcutta.
- 10. Upon completion of Calcutta Bidding Top Five Riders to exit arena to holding area in warm up arena. Wranglers and callers to exit and must stay with their rider.

Judging

- 1. The combined score of the 1st and 2nd Top Five round will determine the placing of the class.
- 2. The previous Thursday Qualifying score is dropped and does not count in the final rounds on Sat evening.
- 3. 50% is on Soft Feel, Harmony and Partnership.

The Top Five Ride

First Round

- 1. Each rider/caller/wrangler will enter arena from warm up arena, one at a time, in order of go.
- 2. The first rider will have 2 minutes before the bell rings to warm up and then 45 seconds after the bell to enter arena at A and begin test. Two minutes will start when rider enters arena.
- 3. Each rider thereafter will have 2 minutes to warm upon entering arena. They will then have 45 seconds after the bell to enter arena at A and begin test.
- 4. Official timer will manage the 2 minute warm up.

Second Round-Same Test as First Go

- 1. All riders, horses, wranglers and callers will return to arena
- 2. Wranglers will hold horses and riders will draw for "the switch" will take place. Wranglers will stay with the horses. Rider cannot mount or handle horse until the 2 minute **notice** is given by **official** timer. The rider then has 2 min to prepare on the new horse as well as another 45 seconds to enter arena and begin test after bell.
- 3. All wranglers, callers, horses and riders must remain in arena for 2nd go tests.
- 4. If there is a saddle change requested, time will be given on an "as needed" basis.
- 5. Buddy horses will be present in arena for competition for all rides. Buddy horses will consist of the placing 6-10.

Presentation of Awards

- 1. Upon completion of all rides, winners will be announced, and the Calcutta winners will be announced.
- 2. Riders do not have to be mounted during awards. Wranglers can hold horses.

Tie Breaker

1. In case of tie, a new mystery test will be ridden by the top two riders. The riders will ride their own horses in this case. This is a totally unknown test to both caller and rider. If a tie continues, the Soft Feel Score will break the tie.

AWARDS

Awards are calculated and given to a single horse and rider combination.

GENERAL RULES AND REGULATIONS

EVERY CLASS OFFERED HEREIN WHICH IS COVERED BY THE RULES AND SPECIFICATIONS DESIGNED BY COWBOY DRESSAGE WORLD, ALL OF WHICH CAN BE FOUND AT www.cowboyDressage.com AND WILL BE CONDUCTED AND JUDGED IN ACCORDANCE HEREWITH.

Rules and Regulations – "RESPONSIBILITIES" The OWNERS, RIDERS, AND TRAINERS are responsible for the knowledge of and compliance with the rules of Cowboy Dressage.

- 1. Entries must be paid prior to the show or at check in. Any unpaid entries will not receive a number.
- 2. Entries must be made on the form provided herein, fully completed, with all required signatures, and accompanied by a check or money order in the full amount, payable to the "Cowboy Dressage World"-any unpaid entry shall not be recorded. No entries will be accepted at if postmarked after 10/15/205 unless the additional post entry fee of \$250 is paid.
- 3. **Exhibitors are responsible for their own errors** and those of their agents in preparation of entry blanks. A horse will not be given a number unless it is entered in at least one class
- 4. **All horses must be registered** through the horse show office brought to the show by trainers or exhibitors.
- 5. Management reserves the right to **change or alter the officials** listed without notice prior to or during the show.
- 6. The age of a Junior/Youth Exhibitor must be 18 years or younger as of date of the show.
- 7. Only assigned cars, trucks and/or trailers will be allowed to park in main barn area, as approved by Show Management. This will be strictly enforced. SHOW MANAGEMENT WILL REQUEST THE MOVING OF RV's OR VEHICLES INAPPROPRIATELY PARKED. Failure to remove vehicle or trailers when requested by show management or Rancho Murieta personnel will result in towing of vehicles at owner's expense.
- 8. Stalls will be assigned by Horse Show Management and will be available on Tuesday, November 3, 2015 at noon. Exhibitors may identify on their entry forms who they would like to be stabled next to but requests for specific stalls will not be considered. Permanent 10' x 12' stalls with full doors (metal) will be available. All stalls used by exhibitors must be returned to their original condition prior to leaving the grounds. Exhibitors will be billed for the cost of repairing any damage to any stalls they use. Any stall used, regardless of reason, shall be subject to the regular stall fee. Only management may reassign stalls. Reassignment may be necessary if an exhibitor cancels after stall assignments have been made or does not use all stalls assigned. Failure to abide by management's stabling assignments may result in an exhibitor being prohibited from competing.
- 9. **Arrival and Unloading.** Due to insurance coverage and the Equestrian Center contract, Cowboy Dressage Finals Show entrants may not move horses in before Tuesday, November 3, 2015. Early arrival fee of \$25 per horse per day will be charged and paid prior to the close of entries.
- 10. **Drug Fees** The California Department of Food and Agriculture (\$5.00). Actual testing at the show may be done by California Department of Food and Agriculture. Exhibitors shall advise of all drugs administered within 72 hours prior to, or during, show. Forms for this purpose will be available in the show office.
- 11. **Use of whips/crops/spurs** only <u>one</u> whip may be carried during a ride. A crop or standard dressage whip not to exceed 4' in length is allowed. Excessive use of the whip or spurs will be penalized.
- 12. **Dogs must be on a leash or confined at all times**. To all dog owners: Due to safety and liability issues, we are increasingly concerned about loose dogs on the show grounds. To prevent accidents or resulting lawsuits, please keep your dog(s) under restraint at all times, and keep us from doing what many shows have been forced to do for insurance reasons, which is to ban all dogs from shows. Thank you!
- 13. **Health Certificates**. All out of state horses (one year old and older) must have a health certificate issued within thirty (30) days prior to show. The state of California requires Coggins papers.
- 14. Bedding and feed can be purchased on site from MEC Contact Shady at 916-985-7334. Shavings are available

at current market. Hay (Grass and Alfalfa) available at a current market value. Please call for pricing.

- 15. **Description of Stalls:** Horses will be stalled in Sections 1 10 comprising of wood and metal structure 10 x 12.
- 16. Minors who do not have a valid driver's license which allows them to operate a **motorized vehicle** in the state in which they reside will not be permitted to operate a motorized vehicle of any kind, including, but not limited to, golf carts, motorcycles, scooters, ATVs or farm vehicles, on the competition grounds. Because of the risk of injury to horses and people, scooters, skates, and skateboards will not be permitted in the vicinity of barns and arenas. Laser beams are not permitted on the competition grounds and will be confiscated
- 17. This show encourages **feedback** from it's owners, riders, and trainers. Please feel free to stop by the office and fill out our feedback form to provide us with your experience and offering constructive input for future events.
- 18. Food Service is provided on the show grounds during the entire show schedule.
- 19. Footing Sand and Soil mixed base.
