#### **Class Division Definition**

- Walk/Jog Test Division
- Walk/Jog/Lope Test Division
- Challenge Test Division
- Vaguero Test Division
- Gaited Test Division
- Partnership
- Freestyle Test Division
- Liberty Test Division

#### Rider Status Definition (See Rules and Guidelines for Detailed Definition)

- Open: Rider that is 18 years or older, who makes a living or receives income from training, teaching/lessons or clinics.
- Amateur: Non-professional rider that is 18 years or older.
- Junior: Rider that is 17 years and under. On show grounds, Juniors are not allowed to handle/ride stallions and must wear a helmet when working with a horse at any time (not just while showing). Age is the age of the rider on January 1 of the current year.
- Silver Rider: 65+ years old (Amateur only for Honorary award)
- Rookie Rider: Amateur Rider in first year of showing (Available for Honorary award)

#### Age of the Horse:

The Cowboy Dressage Horses' age is based on January 1<sup>st</sup> of that calendar year, regardless of the month foaled. For example - a horse foaled anytime in the year 2010 is considered one-year-old on January 1, 2011 and two years old on January 1, 2012.

#### **REMEMBER**

The Cowboy Dressage World Partners want its Members to consider the age and performance level (of both horse and rider) when choosing test levels.

**CALLERS:** The rider is encouraged to memorize their tests. The use of a caller is not mandatory. Cowboy Dressage Gatherings allow the rider to use a caller of their choice, however, the ultimate responsibility for accurate and correct riding of the test falls upon the rider. If the rider chooses to use a caller, it is the rider's responsibility to arrange for one.

**SPOTTER:** A spotter is allowed to walk next to a rider who could possibly become compromised during a test because of existing health conditions. A spotter may not help or speak to a rider during the normal course of a ride (possibility of penalty at the discretion of the judge). However, if the rider is in distress, at that time, the Spotter will step in to help. The Spotter must sign a liability release at the Horse Show office before entering the show arena.

**A Note About Gaited Horses**: The gaited tests are designed specifically for the gaited horse. Gaited horses are welcome in the non-gaited tests but will be scored a maximum high value of 4.5 if gaiting instead of jogging when requested in the non-gaited test.

A Note About Freestyle: If you are considering showing any of the freestyles please be mindful: The Cowboy Dressage Freestyle is a showcase of accomplishments between horse and rider through the levels. The horse and rider must be prepared and able to do the Cowboy Dressage maneuvers successfully with grace, finesse, and respect the freestyle deserves. Partnership, Harmony, and Soft Feel are still a priority when scoring the Freestyle. The Freestyle should be fun and entertaining, while still a celebration of our finest horsemanship.


Freestyle—All freestyle music must be on a thumb drive and must be presented to Office for sound check by Friday, June 18<sup>th</sup> at 5:00 p.m. Please have note of instruction as to when music is to begin. Only one song and one rider on the thumb drive. Phones will not be accepted.

#### **SCHOOLING HORSES**

- Due to liability concerns, horses brought to the show to school are required to register the horse through the office and sign a release.
- Mandatory fees apply (office and drug fees).
- Horse will be given an assigned number, which must be worn at all times when riding.

#### **REFUND POLICY**

- Pre-closing Date (before 6/4/21) A refund for scratched classes, stalls, and drug fees will be issued with a veterinarian certification.
- Post-Closing Date (after 6/4/21): No refunds available after closing date.
- In the case of CDW canceling show, refunds will be given.
- Office Fees are non-refundable in any situation.

#### **AWARDS**

- 1. Class Placing: Classes will be placed from first to tenth place.
- 2. **Ribbon Awards:** Ribbons to be awarded for places one through five.
- 3. **Overall High Single Score:** Award for highest scoring test of show given to the Rider, regardless of Rider Status. Must show in a minimum of 4 classes. (Partnership, Freestyle, Drill Team and Liberty not to count towards Overall High Single Score).
- 4. **Overall High Score:** Award for each Rider Status (Open, Amateur, Junior). Must show in a minimum for 4 classes (Partnership, Freestyle, Drill Team and Liberty not to count toward Overall High Score.
- 5. **Honorary High Score:** Awards will be given to those, regardless of Rider Status, who have declared a Veteran, Cancer Survivor, or Silver Rider (65+ and Amateur only) or Rookie Rider (First Year Amateur Rider) on the entry form. Must show in a minimum for 3 classes (Partnership, Freestyle, Drill Team and Liberty not to count).
- 6. **Soft Feel Award:** Will be awarded to the Rider with the highest Soft Feel Score. In the case of a tie with Soft Feel the Highest scoring test will break the tie. (Partnership, Freestyle, Drill Team and Liberty not to count towards Soft Feel)
- 7. **Jack Brainard Judges' Try Award:** Will be awarded the rider(s) voted most improved during the show by the judges (one award per judge).
- 8. Rookie Award: Will be given to an Amateur Rider in their first year of showing. (Indicate on entry form)

## **High Point Award Eligibility Requirements and Calculations:**

- 1. To be eligible for any award, each horse and rider combination must show in a minimum of **FOUR** classes overall in one of the following: Walk Jog, Walk Jog Lope, Challenge, Vaquero, or Gaited
- 2. Each horse is limited to FOUR under saddle classes per day and FOUR ground classes per day. Liberty is counted as a ground class.
- 3. Top **FOUR** highest PLACED classes will be counted for high score.
- 4. In the case of a tie for the Soft Feel Award:
  - a. A rider's highest Soft Feel score is used.
  - To break a tie the test score for that test is used. Highest scoring test will break the tie.
  - If test scores are tied it is a true tie.

#### **VOLUNTEER OPPORTUNITIES**

**Courts**: Set up and take down courts (including Challenge Court obstacles). Will have early arrival and later departure times. Make sure sound system is ready to go. Call books out. Manure bucket and fork set out. Mounting block set out. Clock up. Chair for gate person. Judge's table with 2 chairs and table cover. Banners (check with Partners about which banners to hang). Assist with reloading cargo trailer.

**Scribe\***: Sits next to judge and writes down comments and scores that come from Judge in a timely manner and in legible handwriting (return supplies to office at the end of day). Best to get some education from an experienced scribe or judge before taking on the task. Must be experienced for Finals. **Gate Person\***: Manage gate by keeping two horses on deck in the court warm up area. They must stay behind A. Be sure riders in holding area are ready to ride at scheduled times. Communicate any time changes, scratches, etc. with judge. Adjust Challenge Court obstacles as needed. Clean up manure in court area. Gather clock, call book and CDW sound system and return to office at the end of day.

Runner\*: Pick up completed tests from scribes in a timely manner from courts. Deliver to office for tabulation.

**Office Helper\***: For the Finals Show we need a friendly face to help greet the participants at the show office window. Other duties possibly included – distributing entry numbers to participants, selling dinner tickets, setting up and taking money for silent auction, assist with scoring tests, ribbon and test distribution, posting results sheets, etc. We have a great time in the office!!

\*Arrival time is 30 minutes prior to assigned work time. Volunteers will check in at Show Office to sign release forms, receive food voucher and other needed information. Contact Bev Meyers (<u>bevmeyers@outlook.com</u> or 916-335-0647) for more information. In case of cancellation please try to fill your time slot.

#### **VOLUNTEER INCENTIVES**

- Each volunteer will receive a voucher (Volunteer Bucks) at the end of their volunteer shift for the show.
- The voucher will be signed and dated by show secretary.
- Vouchers have no cash value and my not be redeemed for cash.
- Volunteer Bucks are received from the 3 shows produced by Cowboy Dressage World: Spring, Summer, and Finals
- Vouchers are good for one year from date received.
- Vouchers can be given for use to another exhibitor only if volunteer does not show.
- Vouchers may be used for show entries (tests) only. No stalling, office or drug fee, bedding, feed, covid fee or late entry fees. They cannot be used at Venue Cafe.
- Vouchers are not replaceable if lost.
- Volunteers who volunteer 4-8 hours per day will get a \$10 food voucher good at the Venue Cafe.
- Food vouchers are not transferable and have no cash value.

#### Credit for Volunteer Bucks as follows:

- For every 4 hours worked = \$20 credit for scribes, runners and gate persons.
- Courts and Banners: 2 hours for court set up (before show starts) = \$10 credit. Court take down at end of show = \$10 credit.

#### **GENERAL RULES AND REGULATIONS**

EVERY CLASS OFFERED HEREIN WHICH IS COVERED BY THE RULES AND SPECIFICATIONS DESIGNED BY COWBOY DRESSAGE WORLD, ALL OF WHICH CAN BE FOUND AT <a href="https://www.cowboydressageworld.com">www.cowboydressageworld.com</a> AND WILL BE CONDUCTED AND JUDGED IN ACCORDANCE HEREWITH.

Rules and Regulations – "RESPONSIBILITIES" The OWNERS, RIDERS, AND TRAINERS are responsible for the knowledge of and compliance with the rules of Cowboy Dressage.

Due to COVID Regulations use the trailer entry gate only. Directions to the back gate will be sent to all entrants. There will also be a gate code number that will be issued for in and out privileges. A face mask is to be worn (except while riding), keep 6 feet separation from non-family members, and follow all CDC protocols.

- 1. Entries must be paid prior to the show or at check in. Any unpaid entries will not receive a number.
- 2. **Entries must be made on the form provided**, fully completed, with all required signatures, and accompanied by a check or money order in the full amount, payable to the "Cowboy Dressage World"-any unpaid entry shall not be recorded. **Post entries \$25 if postmarked after 6/4/21.**
- 3. \$25 Non-member fee. To join Cowboy Dressage for Year-end Awards, sign up at www.cowboydressageworld.com.
- 4. **Exhibitors are responsible for their own errors** and those of their agents in preparation of entry blanks. A horse will not be given a number unless all entries are complete and paid in full.
- 5. **All horses must be registered** through the horse show office brought to the show by trainers or exhibitors.
- 6. Management reserves the right to **change or alter the officials** listed without notice prior to or during the show.
- 7. Only assigned cars, trucks and/or trailers will be allowed to park in main barn area, as approved by Show Management. This will be strictly enforced. **SHOW MANAGEMENT WILL REQUEST THE MOVING OF RV's OR VEHICLES INAPPROPRIATELY PARKED**. Failure to remove vehicle or trailers when requested by show management personnel will result in towing of vehicles at owner's expense.
- 8. Stalls will be assigned by Horse Show Management and will be available on Thursday, June 17<sup>th</sup>, 2021 at noon. Exhibitors may identify on their entry forms who they would like to be stabled next to but requests for specific stalls will not be considered. All stalls used by exhibitors must be returned to their original condition prior to leaving the grounds. Exhibitors will be billed for the cost of repairing any damage to any stalls they use. Any stall used, regardless of reason, shall be subject to the regular stall fee. Only management may reassign stalls. Reassignment may be necessary if an exhibitor cancels after stall assignments have been made or does not use all stalls assigned. Failure to abide by management's stabling assignments may result in an exhibitor being prohibited from competing.
- 9. **Arrival and Unloading**. Due to insurance coverage and the Sonoma County Fairgrounds contract, Cowboy Dressage Gathering Show entrants may not move horses in before noon Friday, June 18<sup>th</sup>.
- 10. **Drug Fees** The California Department of Food and Agriculture (\$8.00). Actual testing at the show may be done by California Department of Food and Agriculture. Exhibitors shall advise of all drugs administered within 72 hours prior to, or during show. Forms for this purpose will be available in the show office.
- 11. **Dogs must be on a leash or confined at all times**. To all dog owners: Due to safety and liability issues, we are increasingly concerned about loose dogs on the show grounds. To prevent accidents or resulting lawsuits, please keep your dog(s) under restraint at all times and keep us from doing what many shows have been forced to do for insurance reasons, which is to ban all dogs from shows. Dogs **ARE NOT** allowed in arenas. Thank you!
- 12. **Health Certificates**. All out of state horses (one-year-old and older) must have a health certificate issued within thirty (30) days prior to show. The state of California requires Coggins papers.
- 13. **Bedding may be ordered on the entry form.** Each bale of shavings is \$12. Only one delivery will be made to stalls so order number of bales accordingly.

- 14. Description of Stalls: Horses will be stalled in assigned sections comprising of wood and metal structure 10 x 12.
- 15. Minors who do not have a valid driver's license which allows them to operate a **motorized vehicle** in the state in which they reside will not be permitted to operate a motorized vehicle of any kind, including, but not limited to, golf carts, motorcycles, scooters, ATVs or farm vehicles, on the competition grounds. Because of the risk of injury to horses and people, scooters, skates, and skateboards will not be permitted in the vicinity of barns and arenas. Laser beams are not permitted on the competition grounds and will be confiscated.
- 16. **JUNIOR RIDERS**: On show grounds, Juniors are not allowed to handle/ride stallions and must wear a helmet when working with a horse at any time (not just while showing).
- 17. This show encourages **feedback** from its owners, riders, and trainers. Please feel free to stop by the office and fill out our feedback form to provide us with your experience and offering constructive input for future events.
- 18. Food Service is provided on the show grounds during the entire show schedule.
- 19. Footing Sand and Soil mixed base.
- 20. **RV Spots** with power and water are available on the show grounds for \$50 (sign up on entry form). Number of sites are limited and will be assigned on a first come/first served basis. 
