

Riding for the Brand was an unwritten code of the Old West but understood by everyone who agreed to live the cowboy life on the open range — that the cowboy should always "ride for the brand." In the early days of the American West, a brand was a ranch's trademark. It meant protecting the ranch and its livestock, whatever it took. The brand also represented pride, duty, stewardship, loyalty and dedication.

Perhaps a few lines of a cowboy poem say it best:

"Ridin' for the brand means to help neighbors and friends; Search for that one last stray, Even though you're tired and it's the end of the day. It's just not the cowboy way to quit."

Cowboy Dressage reflects those principles of being moral, just, fair and dedicated.

Purpose of the Class: This class creates a respectful, educational space where professionals and amateurs ride the same horse in separate tests, showcasing versatility between riders, their partnership, soft feel, and harmony. (Please refer to the CDW Rules and Guidelines for definitions of Open/Professional and Amateur /Junior rider status.)

Class not to count towards horse's 5 daily allotted under saddle rides.

Riders may compete on more than 1 team.

Each horse may only compete on 1 team.

Class Format:

- One horse is ridden by both a Professional and an Amateur rider.
- Amateur/Junior class: Walk Jog Test 3 (WJ3).
- Open (Pro) class: Walk Jog Lope Test 3 (WJL3).
- Tack may be changed between rides to suit each rider's needs within Cowboy Dressage guidelines.
- Each ride is judged with an emphasis on Soft Feel, Partnership, and Willingness.
- Scores from the Amateur WJ3 and the Open (Pro) WJL3 will be combined to determine awards.
- All riders must declare their status (Open/Pro or Am/Jr) at time of entry.
- Standard Cowboy Dressage tack and attire rules apply.
- Support, education, and good sportsmanship are encouraged.

Awards & Recognition:

- The Highest Combined Scoring team
- Team placing continues 2nd-5th
- Highest Single Soft Feel Score Amateur/Junior Rider
- Highest Single Soft Feel Score Open Rider

Code of Conduct: All participants must embody Cowboy Dressage's Golden Rule: Kindness, Empathy, and Respect.

NEW!!! BAAAD Blankets Remuda Rail Class – Rules & Guidelines

Class Description: A Cowboy Dressage rail class where riders work in a group along the rail, demonstrating Cowboy Dressage gaits, transitions and soft feel. Rider's partnership with their horse is also judged.

While riders share the arena, they are judged and placed individually from 1st through 5th place, regardless of the number of entries.

Classes may be split according to size (more than 8 riders) and run in sections, and/or rider divisions (Open, Amateur, Junior) at management's discretion. A ride-off of the top riders can be utilized to pin winners if split classes are warranted at the judge's discretion.

Classes may be held around court (apron/rail) or in a standard arena.



Classes: Walk Jog and Walk Jog Lope

Both classes will be open to Open, Amateur and Junior riders. (Can be split by rider divisions at the discretion of show management).

Purpose: To showcase the horse and rider's Cowboy Dressage skillset in a group setting, with emphasis on soft feel, balance, harmony and partnership while executing various maneuvers.

Judging Criteria:

- Rider's seat, balance, and effective use of aids;
- Soft feel and harmony/partnership with the horse;
- Clarity and correctness of transitions while factoring in safety in a group setting;
- Horse's cadence, rhythm, and willingness.

Gaits & Movements: Judge may call for – Working Walk, Free Walk, Working Jog, Free Jog, Stop, Back, Turn on Forehand or Haunches, Walk on a Loose Rein, Working Lope (in appropriate classes).

For definition of maneuvers or gaits please refer to Cowboy Dressage World Rules and Guidelines.

Judges are allowed to have a scribe and may judge from the judges stand or the middle of the arena.

Eliminations/errors/penalties:

- Please refer to CDW Rules and guidelines for general rules, and tack and equipment rules.
- If the judge notices an equipment malfunction, they have the option to stop the class and for rider to correct the situation in the center of the ring, if possible. However, a penalty will be incurred to the rider entry. The rider has 2 minutes to correct the malfunction. If it cannot be corrected within 2 minutes, the rider is eliminated.
- Attire penalty will result in lower placing or elimination: Refer to CDW Rules and Guidelines
- Switching rein hold from 1 to 2 hands or vice versa or rules on Romel Reins please refer to CDW Rules and Guidelines in the Vaguero section.
- Elimination from Competition or Event: Please refer to CDW Rules and Guidelines.
- If a judge observes a safety concern, a rider may be asked to leave the arena or stop in the center of the arena for the duration of the class.

BIOSECURITY PROTOCOL

Due to recent viral outbreaks in California, MEC has put into place Biosecurity Protocols to help protect horses from infection. Exhibitors are required to record horse's temperature twice a day for 3 days prior to arrival at showgrounds and continue to record temp twice daily while at the show. Temp records need to be posted on stall door of each horse. If your horse shows any signs of illness, please leave them safe at home. Additional information will be sent to show entrants closer to the competition.

Rider Status Definition (See Rules and Guidelines for Detailed Definition)

- Open: Rider that is 18 years or older, who makes a living or receives income from training, teaching/lessons or clinics.
- Amateur: Non-professional rider that is 18 years or older.
- Junior: Rider that is 17 years and under. On show grounds, Juniors are not allowed to handle/ride stallions and must wear a helmet when working with a horse at any time (not just while showing). Age is the age of the rider on January 1 of the current year.
- Silver Rider: 65+ years old (Amateur only for Honorary award)
- Platinum Rider 70+ years old (Amateur only for Honorary award)
- Rookie Rider: Amateur Rider in first year of showing (Available for Honorary award)
- Century Rider: Rider and Horse age total 100 years.

Age of the Horse:

The Cowboy Dressage Horses' age is based on January 1st of that calendar year, regardless of the month foaled. For example - a horse foaled anytime in the year 2010 is considered one-year-old on January 1, 2011 and two years old on January 1, 2012.

REMEMBER

The Cowboy Dressage World Partners want its members to consider the age and performance level (of both horse and rider) when choosing test levels.

CALLERS: The rider is encouraged to memorize their tests. The use of a caller is not mandatory. Cowboy Dressage Gatherings allow the rider to use a caller of their choice, however, the ultimate responsibility for accurate and correct riding of the test falls upon the rider. If the rider chooses to use a caller, it is the rider's responsibility to arrange for one.

SPOTTER: A spotter is a person who is allowed to walk next to a rider who could possibly become compromised during a test because of existing health conditions. A spotter may not help or speak to a rider during the normal course of a ride (possibility of penalty at the discretion of the judge). However, if the rider is in distress, at that time, the spotter will step in to help. The spotter must sign a liability release at the Horse Show office before entering the show arena.

^{*} You may be eligible for more than one CLASS Division (W/J, W/J/L, Vaquero, for example) for high point.

A Note About Gaited Horses: The gaited tests are designed specifically for the gaited horse. Gaited horses are welcome in the non-gaited tests but will be scored a maximum high value of 4.5 if gaiting instead of jogging when requested in the non-gaited test.

A Note About Freestyle: If you are considering showing any of the freestyles please be mindful: The Cowboy Dressage Freestyle is a showcase of accomplishments between horse and rider through the levels. The horse and rider must be prepared and able to do the Cowboy Dressage maneuvers successfully with grace, finesse, and respect the freestyle deserves. Partnership, Harmony, and Soft Feel are still a priority when scoring the Freestyle. The Freestyle should be fun and entertaining, while still a celebration of our finest horsemanship.

FREESTYLE COMPETITION GUIDELINES

Qualifying Ride: Thursday, October 9th

Walk Jog Freestyle – Amateur and Junior exhibitor only Walk Jog Lope Freestyle – Open, Amateur and Junior exhibitors

Championship Ride: Friday, October 10th beginning at 6:30 p.m.

Championships will be the Top 5 Walk Jog and Top 5 Walk Jog Lope riders scoring 68% and above. If rider has more than one qualifying ride, they can only choose one.

Freestyle—All freestyle music must be on MP3 format only and must be presented to Office for sound check by Wednesday, October 8th by 9:00 a.m. Please have a note of instruction as to when music is to begin.

NON-COMPETE HORSES

- Due to liability concerns, all horses brought to the show are required to submit an entry form with signed release forms, vaccination records, and other biosecurity documents as required, including non-compete horses.
- Mandatory fees apply office, drug fees and haul in or stabling.
- Non-competing horses will be given an assigned number, which must be worn when outside of stall.

REFUND POLICY

- Pre-closing Date (before 9-20-25) A refund for scratched classes, stalls, and drug fees will be issued with a veterinarian certification or a medical doctor letter for entrant.
- Post-Closing Date (after 9-20-25): No refunds available after closing date. No exceptions.
- Office Fees are non-refundable
- Be sure to initial that you understand refund policy on official entry form.

AWARDS

- 1. Class Placing: Classes will be placed from first to tenth place.
- 2. Ribbon Awards: Ribbons to be awarded for places one through five.
- 3. Rider Status: Open, Amateur, Junior.
- 4. **Class Divisions:** Walk Jog, Walk Jog Lope, Challenge, Vaquero/Buckaroo (VB), Remuda Rail, Gaited, Partnership (On the Ground/Under Saddle), Freestyle, Horsemanship, and Liberty.
- 5. **High Point Buckles or comparable prizes** will be awarded for each Class Division for Open Status and Amateur/Junior (combined). (Excludes Drill Team)
- 6. **Reserve High Point Ribbons** will be awarded for each Class Division for Open Status and Amateur/Junior (combined). (Excludes Drill Team)
- 7. **Overall High Point:** Awards for 1st through 5th will be awarded to those individuals with the highest accumulative points regardless of **Rider** Status (Open/Amateur), 1st place to Junior riders.
- 8. **Honorary High Score:** Awards will be given to those, regardless of Rider Status, who have declared a Veteran, Cancer Survivor, Silver Rider (60-69 years old, Amateur only, Platinum Rider (70+ years old, Amateur only), Century Rider (horse/rider age equals 100+) or Rookie Rider (First Year Rider-Amateur Only) on your entry. **SELECT ONLY ONE HONORARY AWARD**
- 9. **Soft Feel Award for Class Division (excluding Drill Team):** Will be awarded to the Rider (combined open/amateur/junior) with the highest Soft Feel Score. In the case of a tie with Soft Feel the Highest scoring test will break the tie.
- 10. **Eitan's Soft Feel Single High Score Award:** Highest Soft Feel Score with highest test score (open and am/jr).
- 11. **Overall High Single Score**: Awarded to the individuals who have the **highest single percentage score** for each Rider Status. *Please note that the Freestyle, Partnership, Horsemanship and Liberty tests do not count toward overall high-point nor high-score awards.*
- 12. **Jack Brainard Judges' Try Award:** A special award will be given to the riders voted most improved during the show by the judges (one award per judge).
- 13. **Dr. Robert Miller Rookie Award:** A special award will be given to an Amateur Rider in their first year of showing. (Indicate on your entry)
- 14. **2025 Parelli High Point Award:** Riders participating must be a current "Parelli Savvy Club" Member. Current membership number must be included on entry. All Open and Amateur (combined) Savvy Club Members are welcome. Must show in a minimum of 4 classes.
- 15. **CDW Wyatt Paxton Sportsmanship Award:** Will be awarded to the person who shows the Cowboy Dressage spirit of the handshake and sportsmanship.
- 16. **CDWPA:** Award will be given to Highest Single Score CDWPA member (open/amateur).

High Point Award Eligibility Requirements and Calculations:

- 1. To be eligible for awards, each horse and rider combination must show in a minimum of **SIX** classes overall for Walk Jog, Walk Jog Lope, Challenge, Vaquero/Buckaroo (see #s 2 & 3 below), Gaited, Honorary (Silver, Platinum, Century, Cancer, Veteran, Rookie), High Score and Overall High Point.
- 2. Vaquero/Buckaroo Division for the CDW 2024 Finals will be divided for awards as follows: Vaquero/Buckaroo Walk/Jog – This would be the top 6 scores of a horse/rider combination riding walk/jog tests on either the Open Court or the Challenge Court, or a combination of both courts. Tests that qualify are: Open Court Walk/Jog 1-6 and Challenge Court Walk/Jog 1-4. There will be a buckle for the top Walk/Jog Open rider, and a buckle for the top Walk/Jog Amateur/Junior rider (Amateur and Junior will be combined in 2024 for this division). Please refer to the Vaquero/Buckaroo rules for requirements on tack and attire.
- 3. Vaquero/Buckaroo Walk/Jog/Lope This would be the top 6 scores of a horse/rider combination riding walk/jog/lope tests on either the Open Court or the Challenge Court, or a combination of both courts. Tests that qualify are: Open Court Walk/Jog/Lope 1-7 and Challenge Court Walk/Jog/Lope Tests 1-2. There will be a buckle for top Walk/Jog/Lope Open rider, and a buckle for the top Walk/Jog/Lope Amateur/Junior rider (Amateur and Junior will be combined this year for this division). Please refer to the Vaquero/Buckaroo rules for requirements on tack and attire.
- 4. For Partnership, Horsemanship and Liberty awards, each horse and rider combination must show in a minimum of **THREE** classes overall.
- 5. For Freestyle awards, each horse and rider combination must show in at least one class overall.
- 6. For Drill Team, ribbons will only be given to the Team with the highest score (only one class needed).
- 7. NEW!! Each horse is limited to FIVE under saddle classes per day (Remuda Rail counts as an under saddle class) and FIVE ground classes per day. Liberty and Horsemanship is counted as a ground class.
- 8. Top **SIX** highest PLACED classes will be counted for high point.
- 9. Of a Horse/Rider's highest PLACED classes, the highest SCORED classes will be used. For example, if a horse and rider have 7 firsts the 6 highest scoring tests will be used. *(Freestyle, Partnership, Horsemanship and Liberty do not count toward high point nor high score awards.)*
- 10. Points per placings will be totaled for each Rider Status (example: Open, Amateur, Junior) for each horse and rider combination to determine High Point Awards.

Point Placing Explanation:

- 1. Points per class placing: 1st (10), 2nd (9), 3rd (8), 4th (7), 5th (6), 6th (5), 7th (4), 8th (3), 9th (2), 10th (1) Classes with *one or two* riders:
 - i. Scores under 65.0% will receive no points.
 - ii. Scores of 65.0-69.999 will receive up to 9 points
 - 1. Example #1: two riders. Rider A scores a 65.0% and Rider B scores a 67.0%. Rider B receives 9 points, rider A receives 8 points.
 - 2. Example #2: two riders. Rider A scores 64.2%, Rider B scores 65.0%. Rider A receives 0 points, Rider B receives 9 points.
 - 3. Example #3: one rider. Rider scores 64.999% and receives 0 points. If Rider scored 65.0 receives 9 points.
 - iii. Scores of 70 and above will receive up to 10 points.
 - 1. Example #1: two riders. Rider A scores 64.0%, Rider B scores 70.0. Rider A receives 0 points, Rider B receives 10 points.
 - 2. Example #2: two riders. Rider A scores 72.27%, Rider B scores 76.2%. Rider A receives 9 points, Rider B receives 10 points.

2. Finals will use top 6 placings with the highest scores (possible 60 points). Breaking a tie:

- Rider A on Horse A rides a maximum of 5 qualifying class division tests/day, so 15 potential tests for the show. Of which top 6 placings for the pair can achieve a maximum score of 60 points.
- Rider B on Horse B also rides a maximum of 5 qualifying class division tests/day, so 15 potential tests for the show. Of which top 6 placings for the pair can achieve a maximum score of 60 points.
- Both Rider A and Rider B are tied in points possible.
- Using these 6 placings from each rider the highest scoring test for each rider is selected to break the tie (let's say Rider A is 75.023 and Rider B is 79.345)
- Horse/Rider "B" would be awarded High Point Champion by virtue of highest scoring test that broke the tie.
- -In the case of a tie with the highest scoring tests, the next highest scoring test from each horse/rider pair will be used to break the tie.

3. In the case of a tie for the Soft Feel Award:

- a. A rider's highest Soft Feel score is used.
- To break a tie the test score for that test is used. Highest scoring test will break the tie.
- If test scores are tied it is a true tie.



EVERY CLASS OFFERED HEREIN WHICH IS COVERED BY THE RULES AND SPECIFICATIONS DESIGNED BY COWBOY DRESSAGE WORLD, ALL OF WHICH CAN BE FOUND AT www.cowboydressageworld.com AND WILL BE CONDUCTED AND JUDGED IN ACCORDANCE HEREWITH.

Rules and Regulations – "RESPONSIBILITIES" The OWNERS, RIDERS, AND TRAINERS are responsible for the knowledge of and compliance with the rules of Cowboy Dressage.

General Rules

Schooling: Evening schooling will be available in arena 7. Lights will be provided in this arena only from dusk until 9pm on Wednesday, Thursday, and Friday.

Competitor Responsibilities

- Unauthorized use of stalls will be charged in full to the person(s) using unassigned stalls. If you need an additional stall, please see show secretary.
- Horses must only be washed in wash racks.
- No nails or bolts in the walls, including nails for curtains.
- No hanging items from barn cables.
- No leading horses or dogs from golf carts or other vehicles.
- 1. Entries must be paid prior to the show or at check in. Any unpaid entries will not receive a number.
- 2. Entries must be made on the entry form provided (separate entries for Finals, Riding For The Brand, and Pro*Am can be found on the website here <u>Cowboy Dressage World</u>: Fully completed, with all required signatures, and accompanied by a check or money order in the full amount, payable to the "Cowboy Dressage World" can be emailed to <u>bevmeyers@outlook.com</u> and any unpaid entry shall not be recorded. Post entries are \$100 if postmarked after 9/20/25.
- 3. Entries for the Finals can also be made online at foxvillage.com. Go to entries and follow prompts.
- 4. All entries must have a signed CDW waiver, a signed Rancho Murieta waiver and recent horse vaccination records. You can scan and email your vaccination records to bevmeyers@outlook.com upon submission of entry.
- 5. \$25 Non-member fee. To join Cowboy Dressage for Year-end Awards, sign up at www.cowboydressageworld.com.
- 6. **Exhibitors are responsible for their own errors** and those of their agents in preparation of your entry. A horse will not be given a number unless all entries are complete and paid in full.
- 7. **All horses must be registered**, have a complete entry with signed waivers, vaccination records and paid to receive a number.
- 8. Management reserves the right to **change or alter the officials** listed without notice prior to or during the show.
- 9. Only assigned cars, trucks and/or trailers will be allowed to park in designated parking areas, as approved by Show Management. This will be strictly enforced. SHOW MANAGEMENT WILL REQUEST THE MOVING OF RV's OR VEHICLES INAPPROPRIATELY PARKED. Failure to remove vehicle or trailers when requested by show management or Rancho Murieta personnel will result in towing of vehicles at owner's expense.
- 10. Stalls will be assigned by Horse Show Management and will be available on Tuesday, October 7th, 2025, at 2:00 p.m. Exhibitors may identify on their entry who they would like to be stabled next to but requests for specific stalls will not be considered. Permanent 10' x 12' stalls with full doors (metal) will be available. All stalls used by exhibitors must be returned to their original condition prior to leaving the grounds. Exhibitors will be billed for the cost of repairing any damage to any stalls they use. Any stall used, regardless of reason, shall be subject to the regular stall fee. Only management may reassign stalls. Reassignment may be necessary if an exhibitor cancels after stall assignments have been made or does not use all stalls assigned. Failure to abide by management's stabling assignments may result in an exhibitor being prohibited from competing. *Rules Continues on next page*

- 11. Arrival and unloading. Due to insurance coverage and the Equestrian Center contract, Cowboy Dressage Gathering Show entrants may not move horses in before 2:00 p.m. on Tuesday, October 7th.
- 12. **Drug Fees** The California Department of Food and Agriculture (\$14.00). Actual testing at the show may be done by California Department of Food and Agriculture. Exhibitors shall advise of all drugs administered within 72 hours prior to, or during show. Forms for this purpose will be available in the show office.
- 13. **Dogs must be on a leash or confined at all times**. To all dog owners: Due to safety and liability issues, we are increasingly concerned about loose dogs on the show grounds. To prevent accidents or resulting lawsuits, please keep your dog(s) under restraint at all times and keep us from doing what many shows have been forced to do for insurance reasons, which is to ban all dogs from shows. Dogs **ARE NOT** allowed in arenas, on the bleachers or in food service areas. Thank you!
- 14. **Health Certificates**. All out of state horses (one-year-old and older) must have a health certificate issued within fourteen (14) days prior to show. The state of California requires Coggins papers for horses coming in from out of state.
- 15. Bedding and feed can be purchased on site from MEC order at www.murietaequestriancenter.com. Shavings are available at current market value. Hay (Grass and Alfalfa) available at a current market value. Orders must be made by 2:00 p.m. for same day delivery (otherwise order will be delivered the following day).
- 16. **Description of Stalls:** Stalls are comprised of wood and metal structures 10 x 12.
- 17. Minors who do not have a valid driver's license which allows them to operate a **motorized vehicle** in the state in which they reside will not be permitted to operate a motorized vehicle of any kind, including, but not limited to, golf carts, motorcycles, scooters, ATVs or farm vehicles, on the competition grounds. Because of the risk of injury to horses and people, scooters, skates, and skateboards will not be permitted in the vicinity of barns and arenas. Laser beams are not permitted on the competition grounds and will be confiscated.
- 18. **JUNIOR RIDERS**: On show grounds, Juniors are not allowed to handle/ride stallions and must wear a helmet when working with a horse at any time (not just while showing).
- 19. This show encourages **feedback** from its owners, riders, and trainers. Please feel free to stop by the office and fill out our feedback form to provide us with your experience and offering constructive input for future events.
- 20. **Food Service** is provided on the show grounds during the entire show schedule.
- 21. Footing Sand and Soil mixed base.

Please comply with these policies with your clients, family and friends.

The staff at MEC wishes you a safe and successful event!

- 1. Water is metered, please use this precious resource wisely
- Horses <u>must only</u> be washed in wash racks
- When stabling at MEC, please bring a water bucket and hose. Please do not empty your water buckets in the stall at the end of the show
- It is your responsibility to check your stall(s)/area and sanitize. Any concerns or problems, please call MEC management
- Do not put any nails or screws in the walls (including nails for curtains)
- 6. Do not tie horses or hang items from barn cables
- 7. All garbage and manure must be placed in appropriate disposal areas
- 8. Dogs <u>must be on leash at all times</u> and are not permitted in the food service areas, concessions or bleachers. Proof of rabies vaccination for <u>all Dogs</u> brought to the Facility is required
- 9. No leading horses or dogs from golf carts or other vehicles
- 10. All participants are responsible to sign a liability release with show management
- 11. Parking permitted ONLY in designated areas only (please be aware of fire and emergency access). ALL HORSE TRAILERS & RV's must be parked in designated parking areas. There will be no trailers permitted in the barn isles, including the side and front of the barns; show management is responsible for enforcing and reinforcing this rule throughout the show
- 12. Advertisements and flyer postings are ONLY allowed on the designated "posting boards" located by each arena
- 13. All RV's or living quarters are subject to fees. A "fees paid" sticker will be issued and must be visible to MEC personnel in the window of the vehicle
